Due to the dormant Bermuda grass trying to come out, we would like to keep all carts on the paths for another month. Even after we open the course to carts, we will ask that you stay off 3, 4, 5, and 6, and use cart-path only on those holes all year. No. 3 needs more time to grow-in and mature, and 4, 5 and 6 are very wet and need much more time to dry than other places.

We are going to move the tees closer to the normal playing areas. We are also putting the white tees back to places where they more closely belong. The intention was not for the whites to end up on the reds and with tournament season shortly approaching, we need to be prepared to play them normally.

Also, the Pro Shop will be open until 6:30 p.m. starting daylight savings time. This means people can rent carts and hit range balls right up until 6:30 p.m..
